We look forward to seeing you on the J-Ball court!

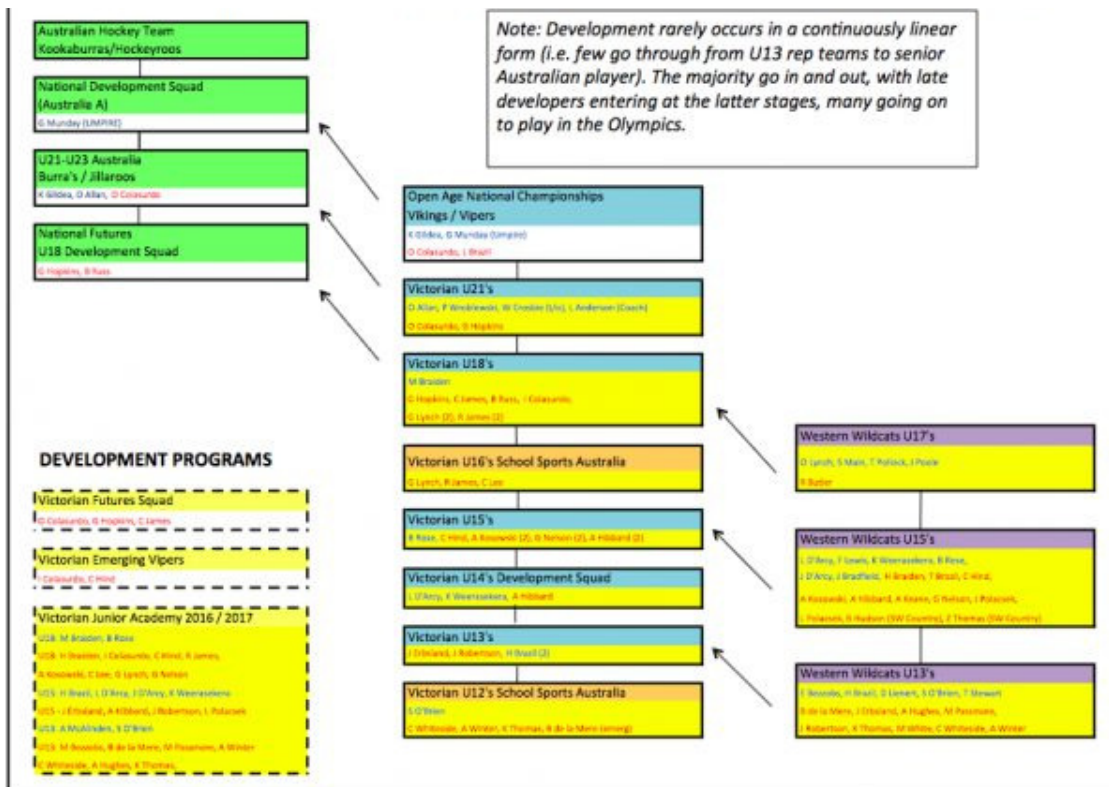
